## **ABOUT THE CBCB FORUM**

The Forum construction bas carbone et biosourcée is an annual event organized by Cecobois and its collaborators, as part of the Construction bas carbone bois et biosourcée (CBCB) initiative. This 3rd edition of the CBCB Forum will bring together professionals and key players in the construction sector, with the aim of stimulating the decarbonization of the building sector and exchanging about the best practices for reducing embodied carbon in a context of sustainable development.

## **OUR MISSION**

Promoting collaboration among construction professionals to work on the reduction of embodied carbon in buildings.

Worlwide, the construction sector is responsible for over 37.5% of GHG emissions. To date, efforts have focused on reducing the energy consumption of buildings, overlooking the fact that a large proportion of GHG emissions in this sector come from the manufacture of building materials especially in Québec.

Bio-based materials derived from renewable resources, such as wood, can replace materials with a high carbon footprint.

- Present the carbon impact of the building and construction sector on the environment
- Equip professionals and organizations to reduce the embodied carbon content of buildings
- Promote low-carbon projects to accelerate the decarbonization of the construction sector
